## Conditions of Licence

1. The Licence and any certificate of renewal in force shall be kept on the approved premises and shall be produced at the request of an Inspector, appointed under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940.
2. Any change in the technical staff named in the Licence shall be reported forthwith to the licensing authority.
3. This Licence shall be deemed to extend to such additional items as the Licence may intimate to the licensing authority from time to time, and as may be endorsed by the licensing authority.
4. The Licence shall inform the licensing authority in writing in the event of any change in the constitution of the firm operating under Licence. Where any change in the constitution of the firm take place, the current Licence shall be deemed to be valid for a maximum period of three months from the date on which the change takes place unless in the meantime a fresh Licence has been taken from the licensing authority in the name of the firm with the changed constitution.
